St. Agnes Academy senior Samantha Pratt has been named a National Achievement Scholar. She is one of only 800 students nationwide to receive a National Achievement Scholarship.

Samantha is a Jack Kent Cooke Young Scholar. She is a member of the National Honor Society, International Thespian Honor Society, Mu Alpha Theta, National Spanish Honor Society and Memphis Challenge. Samantha is the Founder and President of Project Teen Race. She is a four-year member of the track team, a participant in Bridge Builders, a student tutor, and a competitor in Mock Trial. She has performed in several plays at St. Agnes, including a leading role in "The Curious Savage". Additionally Samantha volunteers with a variety of organizations including St. Jude Children's Research Hospital and Invisible Children.

The National Achievement® Scholarship Program is an academic competition established to provide recognition for outstanding Black American high school students. Approximately 170,000 students currently enter the National Achievement® Program each year.
