Funds in Support of Financial Aid

Angela Andreuccetti Award

Established by family and friends in memory of Angela Andreuccetti, this scholarship is awarded annually to a student entering the 9th grade from St. Louis School who maintains good academic standing and demonstrates good citizenship.

Ann and Tom Kavanagh Fund for Financial Aid

Established in 2020 in memory of Ann and Tom Kavanagh, this fund is to be utilized each year for the payment of scholarships and/or other financial aid to a student of St. Agnes Academy – St. Dominic School.

Anna's Angel Fund

Established in memory of Anna Menkel to keep students on the path to academic success during periods of unexpected family crisis.

Anna Caroline Menkel Scholarship

Established in 2005 by Dale and Kathy Menkel in loving memory of their daughter, Anna, this scholarship is awarded to a rising senior with good academic credentials and conduct.

Barbara H. Daush Scholarship

Established in 2016 to honor Barbara Daush and her 22 years of service to St. Agnes Academy-St. Dominic School by the Board of Trustees, this scholarship is awarded annually to a student who maintains good academic standing and demonstrates good citizenship.

Class of 1969 Scholarship

Established in 2019 by the St. Agnes Academy Class of 1969 in honor of their 50th reunion, this scholarship fund is awarded to an Upper School student whose future at St. Agnes is in jeopardy due to demonstrated financial need.

Dominican Sisters of Peace Scholarship

Established in 2014 by the Dominican Sisters of Peace and limited to a rising Junior High or Upper School student from any of the Memphis Catholic Jubilee Schools who meets the admissions criteria for St. Agnes Academy-St. Dominic School and maintains good academics and citizenship.

Dominican Sisters of St. Catharine Kentucky Scholarship

Established in 1999 by the Dominican Sisters of St. Catharine, Kentucky, now known as the Dominican Sisters of Peace, this scholarship is limited to a student with a multi-cultural background who maintains above average academics and exemplifies good citizenship.

Ernestine Watkins Braddic & Molly Goltman Sashkin '61 Memorial Scholarship

Established in memory of Molly Goltman Sashkin '61, to honor Ernestine Watkins Braddic, this scholarship is awarded to an African American Upper School student who demonstrates good academics and citizenship.

Frank Martinez Scholarship

Established to honor Frank Martinez upon his retirement after 31 years of service to St. Agnes Academy, this scholarship is awarded to an Upper School student who has high academic credentials with preference given to Hispanic students or students from any diverse socio-economic background.

James W. Mathis Scholarship

Established in memory of James (Jim) Mathis, a highly respected P.E. teacher and coach at St. Agnes Academy-St. Dominic School for more that 40 years, this scholarship is presented to a St. Dominic student athlete in 6th, 7th or 8th grade who demonstrates good academics and exemplary citizenship.

Kelly Schaffler Scholarship

Established by family and friends in 2003 in loving memory of Kelly Schaffler '79, this scholarship is awarded to a St. Agnes student who is related to a St. Agnes alumna and who exhibits the high morals, character and exuberance for life exemplified by Kelly.

Kristen Mattingly Ellis and Catherine Mattingly Neumann Family Crisis Fund

Established by Mike and Gretchen Mattingly in 2010 in honor of their daughters, Kristen Mattingly Ellis '01 and Catherine Mattingly Neumann '04. Funds from the Mattingly Family Crisis Endowment provide financial assistance to a current student whose ability to continue his or her education at SAA-SDS is jeopardized due to financial hardship caused by the sudden death, critical illness, or accident of a parent or guardian.

Kristin Hargett Scholarship

Established by Steve and Becky Hargett in memory of their niece Kristin Hargett, this scholarship is awarded to an Upper School student with good academic credentials.

Mary Donahue Jorgensen Scholarship

Established by the Jorgensen family in memory of their mother, Mary Jorgensen, this scholarship will provide short-term financial assistance to a current student whose ability to continue her education at St. Agnes Academy is jeopardized due to financial hardship caused by the death of a parent or guardian.

Michelle Kinsella Scholarship

Established in 2008 by friends and family to honor Michelle after her remarkable recovery from a car accident during her sophomore year at St. Agnes, this scholarship is awarded to an Upper School student who exemplifies Michelle's spirit of determination and perseverance.

Michelle Sting Award

Established by the Sting Family in memory of Michelle, a 1992 graduate of St. Agnes Academy, this award is given annually to a student entering her freshman year at St. Agnes Academy from the Lower School.

Rose Ferrante Scholarship

Established by alumni, family and friends to honor St. Dominic School second grade teacher Rose Pacini Ferrante '54 upon her retirement, this scholarship is awarded annually to a St. Dominic student who maintains good academic standing, exhibits good conduct and exemplary citizenship.

Schledwitz Family Scholarship

Established in 2005 by Karl and Gail Schledwitz in honor of their daughters Kathryn '02 and Karly '05, this scholarship is awarded to a student from a culturally diverse background.

Sister Agnes Richarda, O.P. Scholarship

Established in memory of Sr. Agnes Richarda who taught generations of students in the Upper School at St. Agnes Academy, this scholarship is awarded to an Upper or Lower School student at St. Agnes Academy who maintains good academic standing and demonstrates good citizenship.

Sister Anita Marie, O.P. Scholarship

Established by the Manes family in loving memory of their aunt, Sr. Anita Marie O.P., who taught at St. Agnes Academy-St. Dominic School and lived on campus, this scholarship is awarded to a student who evidences good citizenship and maintains good academic standing.

Sister Elise Groves, O.P. Scholarship

Established in memory of Sr. Elise Groves, O.P. who taught Latin and was a former principal at St. Agnes Academy, this scholarship is awarded to a rising freshman who evidences good citizenship and maintains good academic standing. Established in memory of Anita Tadin, a highly respected history teacher at St. Agnes Academy, this scholarship is awarded annually to a rising junior who excels in history, manifests an above average interest in history, and evidences good school citizenship.

Barbara Emanuel Memorial Scholarship

Established in memory of Barbara Emanuel by her son and daughter-in-law, Matt and Paige Emanuel, this scholarship is awarded to a rising junior or senior who intends to pursue a career in education and who evidences good citizenship.

Betty Luttmann Latin Scholarship

Established in memory of Betty Luttman who taught Latin at SAA-SDS for 50 years, this Scholarship is awarded to a 7th-12th-grade student who evidences good citizenship and is currently studying Latin or a World Language.

Brava Scholarship

Leadership Scholarship

Established by the Upper School Peer Mentors to recognize incoming students for their leadership qualities and to encourage them to continue their leadership in high school and beyond, this scholarship is awarded to a rising freshman, who excels in leadership, in their current school, community or church in good academic standing and enrolled at SAA for the coming year.
