Job Title: Basketball Coach - 5th-8th Girls and Boys

Job Summary

The Basketball Coach will provide instruction in basketball fundamentals, team concepts, and game strategies for St. Agnes or St. Dominic 5th-8th grade team(s). The coach must be a dynamic leader that fosters a healthy team environment creating a positive but competitive athletic experience. The ideal candidate will prioritize student-athlete relationships, instill discipline and good sportsmanship, and prepare players for high-level competition.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Qualifications and Skills

- Previous experience playing or coaching basketball
- Strong knowledge of basketball rules, coaching techniques, and strategy
- Excellent communication skills, both verbal and written.
- Successful completion of all required background checks and other school requirements
- Availability for the scheduled basketball season, including practices, games, tournaments, and required athletic meetings. Practices and competitions will generally take place after the regular school day and will include evenings and weekends.

Coaching & Player Development

- Uphold and model the core values of the athletic department: Commitment, Pride, Sacrifice, Work Ethic, and Respect
- Plan and organize engaging and effective practice sessions
- Teach fundamental basketball skills, proper conditioning, and game strategies appropriate for middle school athletes

- Evaluate individual player skills and team performance and provide constructive feedback.
- Supervise all student-athletes before, during, and after games and practices to ensure safety
- Act as a positive role model on and off the court, teaching life skills and character development.

Administrative & Compliance

- Respect and support the faith-based environment of the school
- Follow all school, Athletic Department, league, diocesan (if applicable), and facility policies and procedures
- Complete all required certifications and training (i.e., Sudden Cardiac Arrest, Concussion Awareness, CPR/AED training, Virtus Training)
- Demonstrate appropriate professional boundaries when working with minors and comply with all child-safety and safeguarding requirements
- Establish open, timely, and professional communication with parents, student-athletes, and Athletic Department staff
- Participate in a pre-season meeting with parents/guardians to set clear expectations for the season
- Properly use, maintain, and secure equipment and athletic facilities
- Apply and enforce student discipline and sportsmanlike conduct in accordance with the school's athletic handbook
- Report injuries, disciplinary concerns, or other significant matters promptly to the Athletic Director or appropriate Athletic Department staff
- Work collaboratively with the Athletic Department staff and other coaches to support the overall athletic program

Compensation

This is a stipend position and is considered a part-time extracurricular athletic assignment. Compensation will be provided in accordance with the school's established athletic coaching stipend schedule and policies.
