




SDS Pillars of How Boys Learn Best

• First Half Days of School

- The first half days of school are **Thursday**, **August 12** and **Friday**, **August 13**.
- Your son will be assigned a half-day orientation on either Aug. 12 or Aug. 13
- 8:00 a.m. 12:00 p.m.
- First full day of school is Monday, August 16

• Books and Supplies

- All books and supplies will be at school for your child on the first day of school
 - Includes textbooks, PE shirts (2), digital subscriptions, paper, binders, pencils, etc.
- Parents pay the books and supplies fee on their FACTS account
- Meet-the-Teacher
 - Grade level Meet-the-Teacher meetings will be held at the beginning of the 21-22 school year
 - Dates are TBA
- Technology
 - The Kinder classroom has an iPad cart with individual iPads for Suns
 - iPads are used for independent learning
 - KinderSuns will need a good set of headphones

• Dress code and Uniforms

- **<u>Flynn O'Hara</u>** is the school uniform provider
- Access the <u>SDS K-6 Dress Code</u> here
- Dress uniform is not required for Kindergarten until November/December when Kindergarten students begin attending Mass
- K boys change for PE
 - Kelly decides when they are ready
- Tote bag and nap materials
 - Due to the size of the Kindergarten cubbies and lockers, students must use the purple and gold SDS tote bag provided by the school.
 - All nap items must be manageable for the child. A thin roll-up mat with pillow and blanket attached, small blanket, or small beach towel would be appropriate.

• Lunch/Snacks

- KinderSUNS eat lunch in the Dining Hall
- Pack 2 snacks a day with a water bottle

• Arrival

- Morning carline is from 7:30-8:00 a.m. and is located in the circular drive in front of the St. Dominic School off of Avon Rd.
- \circ $\;$ You can park at IPC and walk your son to the SDS school building

• Dismissal

- Dismissal is at 3:00 p.m. on M, T, TH, and F
- Early dismissal on W at 2:15 p.m. for faculty professional development
- Pickup is located in the circular drive in front of St. Dominic School (same as arrival)
- All Suns need to be picked up by 3:15 p.m. unless they are signed up for EDA
- You can park at IPC and walk to pick up your son
