Job Summary:

The Director of the Theatre is responsible for providing artistic leadership and oversight for the school's theatre program. The ideal candidate is a creative visionary who will lead and grow our dynamic performing arts program and who will inspire students of all ages—from Lower School through Upper School. This role fosters a supportive environment where students feel valued, included, and encouraged to take creative risks. Additionally, this position oversees extra-curricular theatre activities for all grades at St. Agnes Academy - St. Dominic School.

Responsibilities:

- Direct three Upper School productions and assist with one Lower School production and provide artistic leadership across all performances, guiding students through the creative process with high standards and the warmth, consistency, and care that support growth and strong relationships.
- Oversee the theatre, facilities, theatre operations, marketing, and ensure a smooth production process.
- Manage the parent-driven arts support group, Brava.
- Manage the scheduling of the Hook Theatre.
- Foster a culture where students feel seen, valued, and safe to take creative risks and feel like they belong.
- Inform students of local opportunities in the arts.
- Participate in the Orpheum High School Musical Theatre Awards.
- Provide assistance to students who are auditioning or interviewing for college scholarships.
- Plan off campus activities, field trips, and educational excursions for students to instill a love and appreciation of the fine arts.
- Conduct at least one multi-week theatre camp each summer.
- Support the school community and school policies, the teachings of the Catholic Church and the implementation of the Four Pillars: Study, Prayer, Community, and Service

An ideal candidate would possess the following qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in theatre, performing arts, arts education or related field and/or theatre experience. *Master's degree preferred.*
- At least three years of experience teaching and directing theatre productions with the adaptability to engage students across a range of ages and experience levels.
- Excellent communication and collaboration skills.
- Strong organizational skills and attention to detail.
