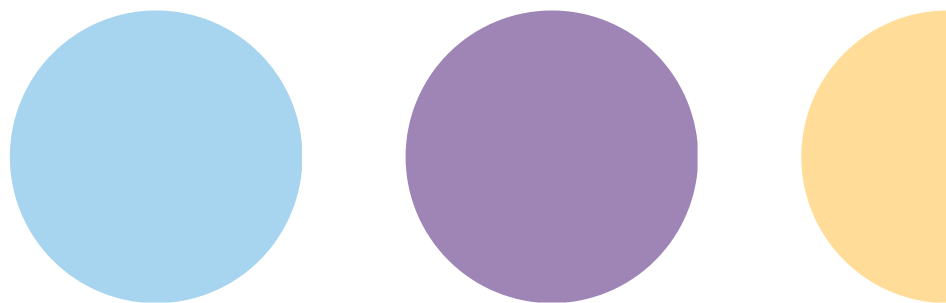

Day Camp

For rising PK–6th grade students

We love creating a fun and enjoyable summer camp experience for our campers! We understand that some may need before and after care. The cost of the full-day camp includes opportunities for outdoor play, craft time, lunch, and special visits from local guests. This option also provides additional outdoor playtime and creative activities, ensuring a day filled with engaging experiences for your child.

Day Camp + 1 Auxiliary Program

For rising PK–6th grade students

If your child needs full-day care and wants to participate in one of our auxiliary programs, this is the perfect option! We will escort your child to their auxiliary camp and bring them back to day camp for the remainder of the day. They will also enjoy lunch with fellow campers.

Day Camp + 2 Auxiliary Programs

For rising 1st–6th grade students

If your child needs full-day care and would like to participate in two of our auxiliary programs, this is the perfect option for you! We will check your child into their auxiliary camps and bring them back to day camp until it's time for their next program. They will enjoy lunch with the other campers.

Camp Holidays:

SAA-SDS Summer Camp will be open on June 19th, recognized as Juneteenth.

Please note that camp will be closed from June 29th to July 3rd in observance of Independence Day. No Auxiliary or Day Camps will occur.

POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Registration

The priority registration deadline is Friday, April 24th, 2026. You must complete the online registration process and either pay in full or establish a payment plan by this date. **A deposit of \$165 per student is required upon registration.**

Registrations will be accepted after the priority deadline if space is still available in the program. However, **if a program has not reached its minimum enrollment by Thursday, May 14th, 2026, it may be canceled.** Early registration is encouraged.

Waitlist

If you find that your auxiliary program(s) are full, please sign up for the waitlist. If we see that there is a long waitlist, we will often open more spots or add another session of that auxiliary program. We will not move a student from the waitlist into the class without approval from the parent.

Withdrawal/Refund

The last day to withdraw and receive a refund is Thursday, May 14, 2026. No refunds will be issued after this date unless there is a case of critical illness or a family emergency. Such situations will be handled on a case-by-case basis and will only be considered if notification is received prior to the start of the specific program. SAA-SDS will withhold a \$25.00 processing fee from all refunds granted.

Confirmation

A confirmation email will be automatically sent to you once your online registration is received.

Program Cancellations and Adjustments

Every effort will be made to prevent the cancellation of a program. Any schedule adjustments or cancellations on our part will be announced at least one week prior to the start of the program. In such cases, a full refund will be provided with no cancellation fee.

Conduct and Dress

Students are expected to behave appropriately and wear attire deemed appropriate during the regular school year. SAA-SDS reserves the right to remove anyone from its programs who exhibits disruptive behavior and/or inappropriate dress. No refunds will be given upon removal from the program. Rising PK-K Students Attending Programs

Students must be at least 3 years old by June 1, 2026, to attend Summer Programs and are expected to be fully potty-trained before the start of camp. If a child has an accident at camp, a parent may be contacted to come to the school to assist the student. If a chronic issue arises, the student may no longer be able to attend Summer Programs.

Late Pick-Up Fees

The Summer Program office understands that unexpected events can happen to anyone. Therefore, on the first late pick-up, no fee will be charged. However, on the second late pick-up, a fee of \$5.00 per minute, per child, will be assessed. All late pick-up fees will be charged to the account on file. Campers attending partial-day programs will be escorted to Day Camp ten minutes after their program ends. If a child is checked into Day Camp, a fee of \$30 drop-in will be charged to the account on file.

Allergies & Medical Conditions

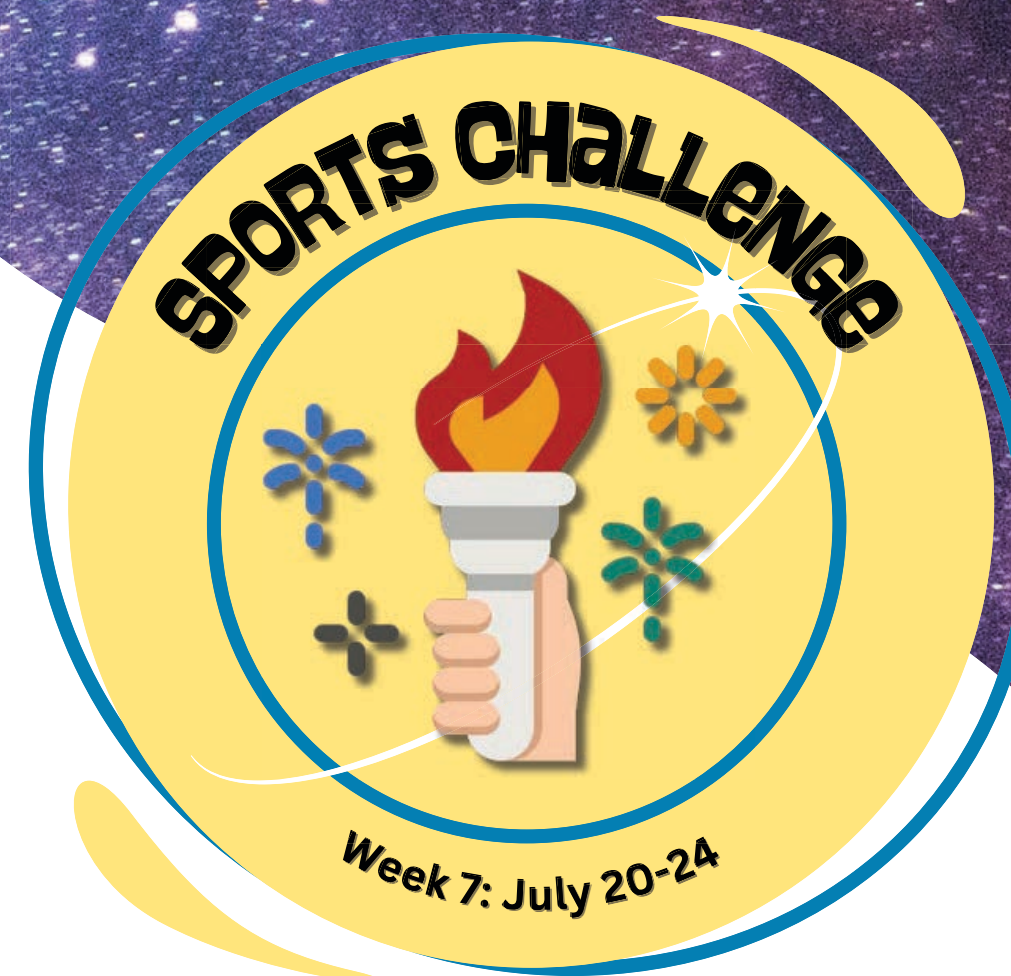
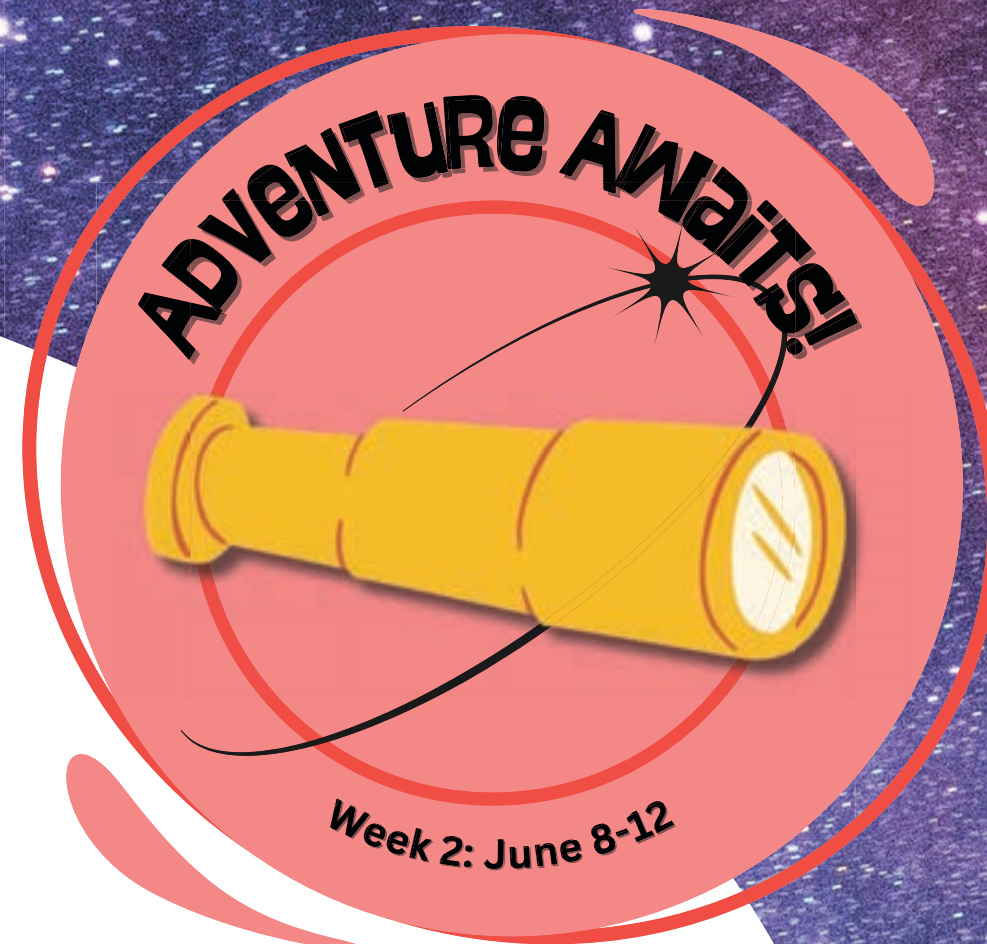

Peanuts are prohibited at SAA-SDS. Any lunches and snacks brought to Summer Programs must adhere to this policy.

Electronics & Other Personal Items

Cell phones are allowed on campus during Summer Programs for grades 5-8 but must be kept out of sight at all times. They may only be used to place calls or receive texts regarding pick-up. No other electronics are allowed. SAA-SDS is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or broken personal items brought to Summer Programs.
