Academic Program

To receive a St. Agnes diploma, a student must complete (Class of 2024):

- 4 years of English
- 4 years of Math
- 3 years of Science (4 years is recommended)
- 3 years of Social Science
- 2 years of World Language
- 1 year of Fine Arts
- 1 semester of Health
- 1 semester of Leadership

Theology is required each year while at St. Agnes. PE is required if the student has not participated in 2 consecutive years of a sport.

COVID-19

SAA moved to remote learning in March 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2020-21 school year was taught using an in-person cohort method to limit COVID-19 exposure.
