The St. Agnes Academy Upper School is a welcoming community where girls are respected for who they are - confident, powerful young women focused on student agency and ownership. Classrooms are vibrant, and girls work together, supporting each other, to achieve their personal best. Guided by experienced and passionate educators, St. Agnes is developing leaders who are intrinsically motivated and genuinely focused on learning.

- Advanced Placement courses are regularly offered in American Government & Politics, Biology, Calculus AB, Chemistry, English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Environmental Science, Human Geography, Modern World History, Precalculus, Psychology, Spanish Language & Culture, Statistics, Studio Art, and United States History.
- In the 2024-25 school year, St. Agnes students achieved a 91% overall pass rate on their AP examinations. Of these students, 39 were named AP Scholars.
- The average class size is 13 and our student-faculty ratio is 7:1.
- SAA participates in the Tennessee Hope Scholarship Dual Enrollment Grant Program with the University of Memphis and Christian Brothers University to grant college credit to students in levels 3 and/or 4 of Honors Spanish and Honors English 4.

Study

The world is changing fast. And while we focus on the timeless strengths and values that have served St. Agnes girls for generations, we also prioritize the technical skills and opportunities that power a 21st-century education.

- Math and Science Center opened for the 2024-2025 school year. This innovative space facilitates collaborative teaching and learning by bringing all math and science education under one roof. It provides space for emerging programming that will challenge and inspire students to learn by doing through experimental activities and real world scenarios allowing our students to think creatively and dream big.
- Through our state-of-the-art Distance Learning Center, learning extends far “beyond our walls.” The anatomy and health classes observe in real time a cadaver demonstration from St. Louis University’s Medical Center, and our Art students have explored various topics with the Los Angeles County Museum of Art. Our students meet authors and collaborate with students from other parts of the country or world through planned debates and novel discussions.
- Our world-class Library combines a traditional physical library with a seamlessly integrated virtual library, offering our students the opportunities to retrieve, evaluate, and synthesize information in a way that is optimal to learning and achievement in a technological world.
- Our Biomedical program provides an exciting and comprehensive introduction to robotics, biomedicine, 3D design and engineering, and investigative research. Our Biomedical Science sequence, allows students to investigate the roles of biomedical professionals as they study the concepts of human medicine, physiology, genetics, microbiology, and public health.



Community



St. Agnes girls learn what it means to live in community.

Community is the foundation of who we are. When you become a St. Agnes girl, you are joining a timeless community bound by shared experiences and amazing growth. Here, remarkable girls become extraordinary women while sharing in traditions that build a sense of belonging. While striving for their personal best, girls collaborate and support one another, creating a sisterhood where all are embraced and each can shine.

St. Agnes Academy is committed to the respectful treatment of all people. Our student-led honor council is charged with upholding the academic and social integrity of our students and their interactions with others.

The lessons learned at the Academy in the classroom and on the field, the memories shared from the lunch table to Spirit Week, and the relationships formed with friends and educators will last a lifetime.

We are creating, cooperating, and competing.

St. Agnes Academy provides opportunities outside the classroom for our girls to excel. The arts thrive in our three Fine Art studios, and 300-seat performing arts center. From SGA opportunities to student-led clubs and academic teams, your daughter can find her place and develop her talents. Our sports teams and clubs strive for excellence, as proven through competitions across the city and region.

- The Upper School Theatre Department produces three plays every year. Students are recognized and awarded for their performances by the Orpheum High School Musical Theatre (HSMT) Awards. In 2024, SAA earned 15 nominations and 6 awards. Recent productions include *Leaving Iowa*, *The Addams Family*, and *Matilda*. Our two vocal groups, Starlettes and Ladies First, perform on campus and in the community.
- Talented artists and writers produce our national-award-winning literary magazine, *Calliope*, and our annual yearbook, the *Aquila*.
- Every year we offer a variety of student trips including rafting on the Ocoee River, a New York fine arts trip, Spring Break trip to Europe, and our Costa Rican exchange program.
- In athletics, St. Agnes was named the Best of the Preps for the Female Division for five consecutive years. Our Stars compete in a variety of sports including basketball, bowling, cheer, cross country, golf, lacrosse, soccer, softball, swimming, tennis, track, and volleyball.
- Our golf team won the regional title for 16 consecutive years, and our bowling team has been state champion 6 times, and the current reigning champs for 2025!
- Campus life offers over 25 clubs and organizations, 9 honorary societies, 7 academic teams, musical ensembles, and student-led publications.



Learning to make a better world.

It has always been our vision to instill in each student the desire and ability to make the world a better place. Though the school offers a range of service projects, students are also encouraged to create their own service projects when they see a need.

We know service experiences cultivate and energize our students' understanding of their potential to be agents of positive change in our Church, our community, and our world. Every day we see students gaining a broadened perspective and a heightened sense of purpose.

- Every year, our Upper School students volunteer over 15,000 hours of service to the community.
- The Day of Caring has been a St. Agnes tradition for over 25 years.
- The Forever Friends Club partners with students at Madonna Learning Center.
- Our Upper School students serve as retreat leaders for our Lower School and St. Dominic students, building community across our campus.
- Capstone Project: *Catholic Social Teaching: Christian Life in Society and the "Path to Caritas" Project*

This project explores the major themes of Catholic social teaching and how they express God's plan for all people, with a goal toward inspiring students to a life of service. Our seniors explore injustices in our society, connect with local non-profit organizations, and apply Catholic social teaching to current social issues, such as protecting human life and dignity, defending human rights, promoting peace, advocating for economic justice, and safeguarding God's creation.

Our girls can go anywhere.

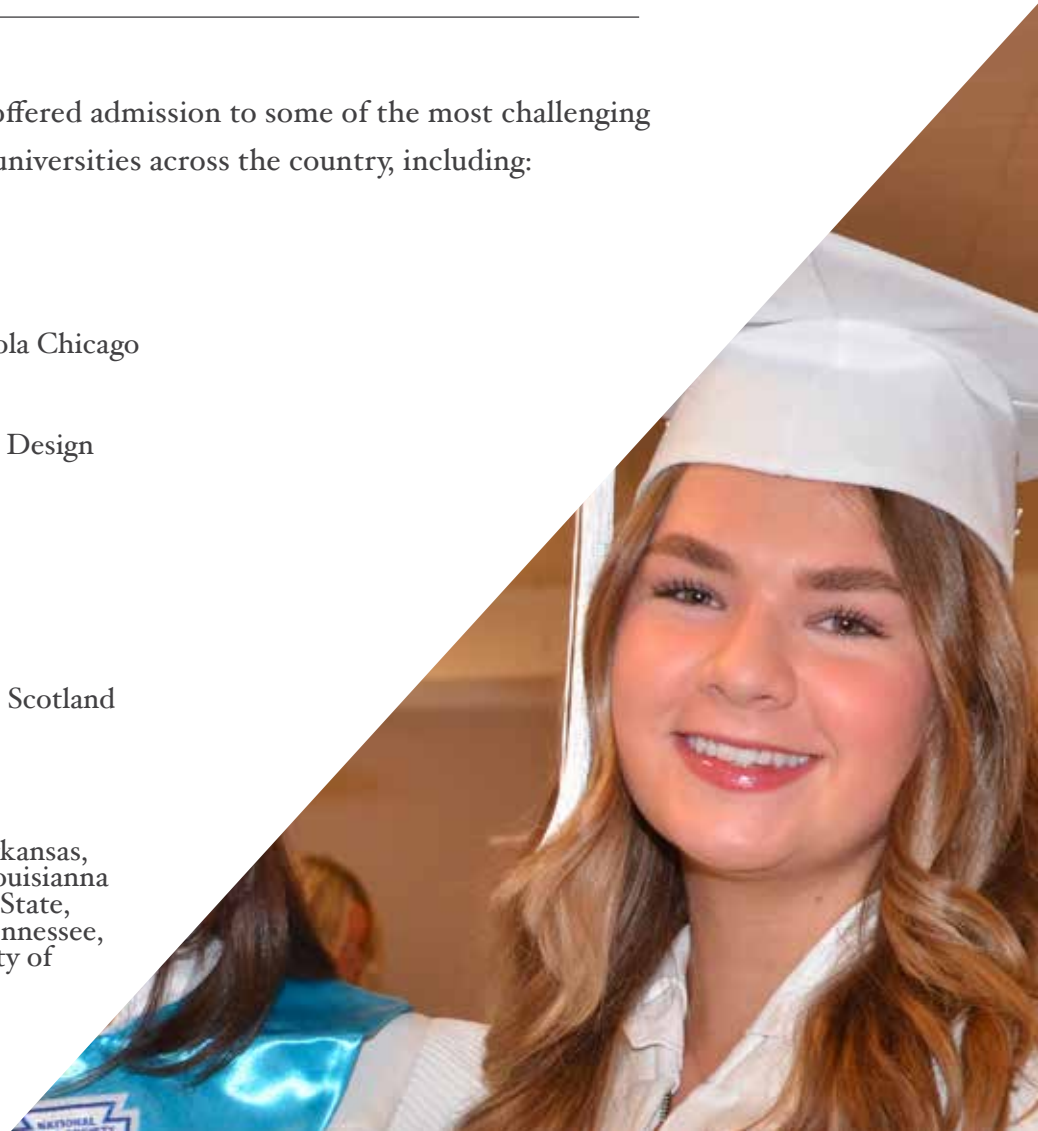
